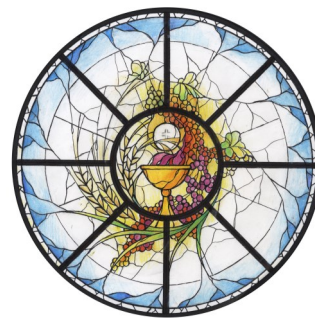

EXTRAORDINARY MINISTERS OF HOLY COMMUNION

Distribute the Body and Blood of Christ during mass, and to the ill and homebound.

- 1) Has received all three Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Eucharist, & Confirmation)
- 2) Is at least a Junior in High School
- 3) Is person of prayer and Eucharistic faith;
- 4) Is Catholic in good standing

MINISTERS OF HOSPITALITY

Both of these ministries help create a welcoming environment and a sense of community.

- ◆ **Greeters** are the first and last community members that worshipers meet. They welcome all, introduce visitors, help with registering new parishioners, and distribute bulletins. Our greeters can be men, women, and older children who have a love for our community and a welcoming spirit.
- ◆ **Ushers** help with the movement of the faithful as they enter and exit the worship space and during Holy Communion (and other liturgical processions). They also assist with the collection(s). Ushers can be men, women and teens who are warm and outgoing. Families are welcome to usher.

MUSIC MINISTRY

Open to anyone in the parish who sings or plays an instrument. Ministry groups include:

- **Adult and Children's Choirs**
- **Cantors**
- **Instrumentalists**

MINISTERS OF THE WORD

Proclaim the living Word of God to the community and, if a Deacon is not present, pray the Universal Prayer.

- 1) Possesses a love for God's Word
- 2) Studies and prays with God's Word
- 3) Possesses a good, clear speaking voice,

WORSHIP COORDINATORS

Ensure that all of the ministers needed for their assigned mass are present and prepared to execute their ministry. They set out the hosts and wine for mass, invite a family to present the gifts, oversee the collection, and coordinate the Presentation of the Gifts

ALTAR SERVERS

Serve God and the community through their presence and assistance at the altar. Open to students, **4th grade and older**, who have made their First Communion, and are mature enough to understand their responsibilities and to carry them out well and with appropriate reverence. Students in **8th thru 12th grade** who demonstrate leadership ability will be trained as **Lead Altar Servers**.

SACRISTANS FOR DAILY MASS

Responsible for making sure all the necessary elements for daily mass are laid out (liturgical books, vessels, linens, Eucharistic elements) and cleaned up. Also sees that there are enough ministers that day (Lector, Eucharistic ministers, & gift bearers).

ALTAR GUILD

Members care for the altar linens used during all our Masses. Members of the altar guild are scheduled for ministry approximately once every other month.
